

MISSION

The Rural Adult Program (RAP) provides services for adults with developmental disabilities. RAP is a day training service. Our mission is to prepare people with disabilities to realize their full potential as individuals and as productive citizens. This is achieved by integrating people into the community while developing and maintaining personal, social, leisure and work skills.

HOURS

We operate from 8:45 am to 3:45 pm Monday through Friday, twelve months a year excluding holidays.

PEOPLE SERVED

All who meet the state definition of developmental disability or a similar handicapping condition and are over 18 years of age are eligible for services. The definition includes intellectual disabilities, autism, cerebral palsy and epilepsy that originates before an individual attains the age of 18. Similar handicapping conditions include those found to be closely related to intellectual disabilities, or to require treatment similar to that required for individuals with intellectual disabilities.

SERVICES

All programs provide assessment and training in:

- **Communicating Choices**



- **Recreational Activities**



- **Work Skills**



- **Independence In Self-Help Activities**



All training provides meaningful activities similar to that of the non-disabled population. Skills taught are specific to individual choices, interests, needs and abilities.

Enhanced Services provides support at a 1:2 ratio for people with exercise needs directed by a physical therapist and or require other significant physical supports..

The **Behavior Management Activity Center (BMAC)** serves people at a 1:3 ratio, and teaches social and safety skills by offering positive reinforcements, praise, and choices both on-site and in the community.

OTHER SERVICES

RAP coordinates and assists in providing communication training, occupational therapy and behavior management services when authorized.

RAP is co-sponsored by the Ukiah Unified School District Adult School, vendored by the Redwood Coast Regional Center and licensed by the Department of Social Services.

COST

Service fees are paid for by the Redwood Coast Regional Center for those eligible. Third party sponsorship is also possible.

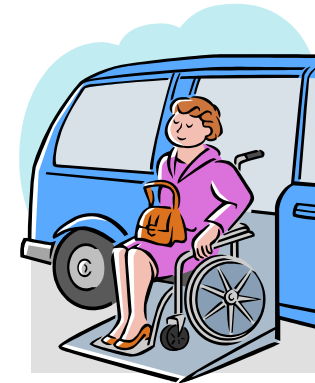
